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2 Peter 1:3 For His divine power has bestowed upon us all things that [are requisite and suited] to life and godliness, through the [full, personal] knowledge of Him Who called us by and to His own glory and excellence (virtue). 4 By means of these He has bestowed on us His precious and exceedingly great promises, so that through them you may escape [by flight] from the moral decay (rottenness and corruption) that is in the world because of covetousness (lust and greed), and become sharers (partakers) of the divine nature.5 For this very reason, adding your diligence [to the divine promises], employ every effort in exercising your faith to develop virtue (excellence, resolution, Christian energy), and in [exercising] virtue [develop] knowledge (intelligence),6 And in [exercising] knowledge [develop] self-control, and in [exercising] self-control [develop] steadfastness (patience, endurance), and in [exercising] steadfastness [develop] godliness (piety),7 And in [exercising] godliness [develop] brotherly affection, and in [exercising] brotherly affection [develop] Christian love.8 For as these qualities are yours and increasingly abound in you, they will keep [you] from being idle or unfruitful unto the [full personal] knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed one).9 For whoever lacks these qualities is blind, [spiritually] shortsighted, seeing only what is near to him, and has become oblivious [to the fact] that he was cleansed from his old sins.10 Because of this, brethren, be all the more solicitous and eager to make sure (to ratify, to strengthen, to make steadfast) your calling and election; for if you do this, you will never stumble or fall.AMP

How many times have you heard it said, after someone's behaved badly; "Well, I just can't help it. It's just the way I am. It's my personality?" Probably more times than you'd like to recall. Moreover, have you ever had to endure someone who made excuses for their unpleasant moods, blindly disregarding how damaging their temper, outbursts and sulking were to others? It's so sad! But, this is an unsettling issue we all may face. For that reason, I'm of the opinion that it's even worse when similar defenses spew from the mouth of a Christian sister, brother, or the unthinkable, a minister or Christian leader.

Because of what seems to me to be an increasing frequency of ill manners, I'd like to pose some questions. Is such dismissive, self-justifying behavior acceptable in Christian conduct? Let me dare to say. No! It's not! What's more is that after having personally encountered this very phenomenon, repeatedly in Christian circles, I've come to the conclusion that many believers, along with ministry leaders, don't have a clue concerning about what the Scriptures instruct us in how we should behave. This is also because I don't know whether they're truly knowledgeable of what has been practically accomplished in the redemptive © 2015 Tamara Winslow



Part One: Becoming Who You Really Are!

#### By Dr. Tamara Winslow

New Birth in connection with the transformation of the human psyche. Regrettably, and all too often, psychology and stereotypical personality evaluations have misplaced and over-ridden the truths of living out genuine Christian personality. Without realizing what has happened I believe we've exalted the fallen nature in such a way that the born-again personality is nearly unknown in living practice. So, what's going on?

I believe that a dangerous crisis has been developing for a long time pertaining to the disregard of the relevance of numerous Biblical doctrines for contemporary believers. Those doctrines include what it means to be spiritually-minded, the doctrine of the New Birth, redemption, salvation and the doctrine of the fruits of the Spirit. I've long been dumbfounded by how quickly spiritual mindedness gets swapped out for carnal excuses that are subtly wrapped in words that appease the fallen nature, by denying the sometimes uncomfortable truths of what's been accomplished in redemption. So let's consider some things. How is it that we who claim to follow Jesus, as born again individuals, renovated back into the image of God, can so easily dismiss bad character and moodiness as "just who I am". Truthfully, we can't! What's more, it seems that we've excused away bad manners and moods as normal for Christian living. We need a move of God's Spirit to bring about a unique condition of revival. I say this because there needs to be a big change in how we as believers relate to one another, as well as how we represent Jesus before the world. We forget that people are watching.

## 2 Cor 5:16 Wherefore henceforth **know we no man after the flesh**: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more.

2 Cor 5:16 Consequently, from now on **we estimate and regard no one from a [purely] human point of view [in terms of natural standards of value].** [No] even though we once did estimate Christ from a human viewpoint and as a man, yet now [we have such knowledge of Him that] we know Him no longer [in terms of the flesh].17 Therefore if any person is [ingrafted] in Christ (the Messi-ah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!AMP

Col 2:8 See to it that no one carries you off as spoil or makes you yourselves captive by his so-called philosophy and intellectualism and vain deceit (idle fancies and plain nonsense), following human tradition (men's ideas of the material rather than the spiritual world), just crude notions following the rudimentary and elemental teachings of the universe and disregarding [the teachings of] Christ (the Messiah). AMP

Paul, when talking about the New Creation personality, said that we should not know, or regard, anyone according to the fleshly nature. Therefore we should not judge any individual through natural judgment based on "fallen", natural standards. Regrettably, his tenet is seldom applied in how contemporary believers relate to one another because we've naively accepted a deadend, man-made philosophy about human temperament that stereotypes people according to worldly boxes and limited psychological standards. It goes without saying that as the philosophies of men have replaced spiritually minded living truths, we gradually lost the ability to take into account the Biblical actualities of what redemption has accomplished in the inner person. What's more the priceless realities of the work of salvation, the accomplishments of the cross and the victories obtained through resurrection are often absent in how believers walk out their faith with one another. In truth, we've been robbed by the philosophies of man, just as Paul warned us not to allow to happen. These things must change.

Revival is a theme that has woven itself like a distinctive manycolored strand throughout the fabric of my life's work. With that in mind, I may be somewhat qualified to comment that if there is any type of "revival" that needs to occur in the contemporary Church, it is a revival of godly character fostered by the spirit of holiness. This revival would then be manifested because of a renewed understanding of the work of salvation in the inner being. It would consequently also be embodied by the fruits of the Spirit described in Galatians chapter 5.

I've long wanted to write about the fruits of the Spirit, as in contrast to the works of the flesh, because I believe there is a great need for a return to these forgotten necessary truths. Sadly, even though I'm impressed that this message is prophetic in nature, I fear that many believers and ministers of the Gospel will dismiss this teaching as unnecessary, irrelevant and too elementary for their attentions. Nonetheless, I'm compelled to put it in writing so that those who read it may be moved to choose to take on a real Christianity and be shining lights of Jesus in this present world. On top of this, from what I've observed, a kind of spiritual blindness has gradually draped a blanket of deception clouding the conviction of conscience and dimming the eyes of many believers to these problems.(2 Pet. 1:9) Therefore, I'm pressed to ask; what should we investigate to confront this unrecognized crisis?

#### 2 Tim 3:1 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.<u>2 For</u> <u>men shall be lovers of their own selves</u>..;5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.KJV

Paul the apostle warned that one of the first signs of the Last Days would be that people would be lovers of their own selves. This means, people will be lovers of their identity and personality. Essentially, folks will be too intent on their personal interests and consequently selfish in nature. As a result, one focus in the Last days will be about whatever satisfies and elevates self. I often wonder, whether the growing trend, of taking "selfies" photos, is just one more indicator of the end time's characteristic. Regrettably, it also needs to be noted that seductive forms of narcissism and physical vanity have even snuck into Church circles. Maybe it's just my opinion, but it seems that success, the appearances of wealth and personal beauty has gradually sacked the truths of humility, servanthood, holiness and beauty of the spirit. Furthermore, individual and corporate conscience. as being the primary reservoir and expression for the boundaries for right and wrong, truth and values, has subsequently undergone a measured collapse. As a result, the parameters for godliness have taken second place to an emphasis on individual identity. Personal worth, success and the fear of shame has become a ruling force in much of society, and sadly, even the Church. Sadly, these expanding issues have constructed a large scale platform for carnality and will not be defeated easily because the love of self always despises the Lordship of Jesus. What must we do to see this mess addressed?

Rom 8:1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit...4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be 8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. KJV

**Number One!** Believers must be educated, or probably better said, *trained* in what the Scriptures describe as being spiritually minded. We will never know one another according to the Spirit, if we judge one another because of a fallen view. Therefore, we need to take a more prudent look at what the Scriptures say what we are and are not. Paul's letters to the churches in Rome and Galatia take detailed pains to make sharp distinctions between spiritually-minded lifestyles in contrast to being fleshly, or carnally driven. His letters also warned that to be spiritually

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minded inevitably meant you would be engaged in an unseen battle. Yet, even though the saint participates in a daily warring engagement between flesh and spirit, few believers really know what's going on. Practically speaking, many believers don't realize that they don't have to end up the victim in this fight. For this reason, spiritual mindedness and carnality need to be clearly defined. Otherwise you'll never truly know how to deal with your personality and, what's more how to relate to others from a godly basis. You must understand these distinctions.

I want to help you realize that spiritual mindedness isn't something spooky. It also isn't emotional hype. In fact, sometimes, because of ignorance, or, being zealously driven, believers manifest behaviors that are simply fleshly excess. They then wrongly assume that emotionalism is equivalent to being spiritual. On the

other hand, genuine spiritual manifestations, may exhibit demonstrativeness random that is Biblically confirmed as being sometimes associated with the power of the Holy Spirit. Regrettably, these occasional behaviors are then criticized as hyper-emotional, or being "too spiritual". Neither opinion is correct. In truth, however, spiritual mindedness will affect the emotions and behaviors. But, if you wanna be Biblically accurate, it is more often the condition of heart that simply means you're

focused or intentionally attentive to what God is speaking in whatever ways He chooses. Spiritually mindedness is also exemplified by a heartfelt diligence that believes and practices living in accordance with accurate interpretations of the Scriptures. The spiritually minded saint is a prospector in God's word, digging and sifting through the Bible. They attempt to rightly dissect each word and verse. But, an outstanding characteristic of spiritual mindedness is that it's insistent about pursuing a closer love relationship with God. Carnality is only concerned with externals, feelings and the moment. Therefore, faith has no place in the carnal life. Paul, furthermore, rightly connects spiritually mindedness with having and practicing faith, both of which please God. This shouldn't be ignored.

Now, think about this. If spiritual mindedness is discounted, the believer then becomes what Paul called carnal or fleshly. Biblically, there's host of problems that carnality brings into being in the human life. Characteristically, believers who are carnally minded pay more attention to, and are generally overly consumed with their external life, their physical appearance and condition. Carnal individuals are also often obsessively fixated with their health, their social situation, as well as their natural and psychological states. This is because many Christians don't realize the truth about what's been accomplished through salva-© 2015 Tamara Winslow

tion and the redemptive work of the New Birth. As a result, they don't understand what they actually should be focusing on. Or, even if they know what belongs to them, they may only believe it casually. Please understand this. Faith is never passive. It isn't lightweight. So the fact of the matter is, spiritual mindedness must be taught, *caught* and <u>constantly</u> chosen. You see, carnality tends to compel a person to live for the moment, for the feeling. It also gets stuck in the reasoning realm. As a result the believer unwittingly ignores the truths of Scripture. In view of that, carnal believers are often highly emotional or what could be called "feeling junkies". They also fall prey to the philosophies of men, and demonstrate a combination of religiousity and lawlessness, that is displayed in how they try to *walk* out their faith.

Gal 5:24 And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.KJV

Spiritual mindedness must be taught. But, there's often a problem that affects the process of its being instructed. Consider this. Until a believer realizes its significance, and then endeavors to grow in the daily revelation of redemption, an unforeseen foe slinks in on the scene. That enemy is legalism, which is also supplemented by a works mentality.

Brothers and sisters, beware of the legalism that camouflages itself in pseudo spirituality. Legalism inescapably blinds the believer to the

truths accomplished in the New Birth. God's gift of righteousness is therefore not understood. It then seduces the saint to make him or her try to fulfill Old Testament laws while at the same time the soul unwittingly descends into a deadly abyss of doing works to earn God's grace. Legalism makes itself seem as if it is spiritual mindedness, but in fact it isn't. This is because there is little understanding about redemption! Regrettably a large majority of believers have failed to grasp the genuine spiritual transformation that's occurred in salvation. So, therefore, when you aren't spiritually minded, and try to be so with the wrong foundations, you'll live contrary to what's been done in the New Birth. For this reason carnal believers inevitably practice a religious life that mimics spirituality, but in reality, it isn't. All of this activity is because there is a perpetual war going on inside of the born again person and that fleshly contest is fueled by lust.

1 Peter 2:11 Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, <u>which war against the soul;</u>KJV James 1:14-15

1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.KJV

Peter, the apostle, stated that as lust fosters sin it generates a war in the soul. I can't remember the last time I heard a sermon about combatting the lusts of this world, the lust of the flesh and



the lust of the eyes. Sin exists in the believer's life because lust isn't recognized and repudiated. Lust should be considered an illegal trespasser in the Born again life, but as Paul related in Romans 6:6-7, 12-20; 7:9-25; Galatians 5:24; it must be intentionally refused and crucified. Thankfully, even though this battle is constantly present, we don't have to let lust rule us. We don't have to give sin have dominion over our lives. We can fight it by choosing to be spiritually minded and walk in the Spirit. (1 Timothy 6:9; 2 Timothy 2:22; Titus 2:12; 3:3; James 4:1, 5 ) Nonetheless, another sign of the Last Days is the advancing of teachers and teachings that reinforce carnality. Believers should discern the emergence of so called Christian teachers who declare ideas that push doctrines that support lifestyles which ignore repentance, holiness, carnality and popular psychology as the way of spiritual living. These are once again fruits of lust.

2 Timothy 4:3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; <u>but</u> <u>after their own lusts</u> shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;

Dear ones please bear in mind that once you make the decision to grow in spiritually minded living, you're automatically con-

scripted into an intense war. The fleshly nature contests redemption. Paul specifically warned the Galatian church that the flesh always persecutes the spirit. Perhaps this is also why, when Paul said we must "walk in the Spirit", he used a Greek word for walk that refers to marching in rank or exhibiting a military sort of discipline. Walking in the Spirit, and being spiritually minded, requires the sternest of self-restraints in that you calculatedly choose to focus on the truths that cause you to model God's nature and or personality, to the world around you. This process, however, doesn't happen overnight.

Eph 4:22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; 23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.KJV

Ephesians 4:22 states that we must be renewed, or one could say, be constantly <u>revived</u> in the spirit or attitude of our minds. This is accomplished by putting on, like a garment, the new man or renewed personality that has

fort, and it may be painful to resist the lusts that contradict God's righteousness and Spirit. Consequently, the spiritually minded believer sees a different perspective of self and identity, as based on what has happened in the transforming power of being born again.

Many things could be said about the spiritually minded life. But as we continue in this series of teaching, I would ask you to take a hard look at how you're living. Are you endeavoring to live in a manner that forbids your moods, words, personality and attitudes from ruling you contrary to the truths of what God has recreated you to be? Do you make excuses for nasty behaviors as just being who you are? Then, are you wanting to live differently?

These questions need honest attention. The people we relate to, the ones we walk and work with see the truth about us and whether we are living according to what God has accomplished in us through redemption. If you dare, ask the people you are with everyday if you are demonstrating a spiritually minded life or

exhibiting a carnal manner of behavior. It might shock you as to what they are really experiencing when you're on the scene. Then, if you can accept those things as challenges, seek the Lord as to what revelations you need to grow in. Repent if you have caused pain. Stop making excuses for ill manners and become the shining light Jesus intended vou to be. These are tough challenges. But, once you start down this path, and make intentional choices to be spiritually minded, other revelations are sure to begin to grow in you. This is a holy discipline we can't ignore.

The next article in this series will address how the New Birth effects our behaviors, words, relationships and more. What a tremendous possibility we have ahead of us if we embrace these truths. You have become a partaker of His divine nature/ personality because He's made a way for you to escape the corruption that's in the world's system through lust. That way
